Navigation Law Update Life Jacket Wear Requirements

Beginning Nov. 1, 2009, Section 40, Subdivision 1 of the Navigation Law shall be amended by adding new paragraph (e), which reads as follows: No owner or operator of a pleasure vessel less than twenty-one feet, including rowboats, canoes, and kayaks shall permit its

operation, between November first and May first, unless each person on board such vessel is wearing a securely fastened United States Coast Guard approved wearable personal flotation device of an appropriate size when such vessel is underway. Failure to wear a lifejacket on

such vessels will be considered a violation under Section 73-c if the Navigation Law and is punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$250, applicable to either the operator and/or the owner of the vessel.

Spillway Committee Report Tim Hopkins

We realize that there are many new homeowners in the community and we would like to explain the procedure and the reasoning for drawing down the lake in the fall. Our 2010 Lake Management Plan states that we are to begin winter draw down by removing the board from

the spillway the day after Columbus Day and slowly drawing down the lake through October and completely opening the gates on the spillway by November 30 of each year. The reasons for drawing down the lake are two-fold. First, when the lake is drawn down any milfoil or curly-leafed

pondweed that is exposed to the frost will be killed on the shorelines. Secondly, when the ice goes out in the spring erosion of the shoreline is less likely if the lake is at the draw down level. We monitor the level of the lake throughout the year by opening or closing the

spillway when necessary to maintain the proper water table so that septic systems around the lake can function more efficiently. If you have any questions on the spillway please feel free to call Tim Hopkins @ 692-8557 or email hoppy087@netzero.net.
